Since the end of the armed conflicts that devastated Europe in the 20th century, the promotion of democratic memory policies has become a moral duty which requires reinforcement in order to neutralize oblivion and avoid a repetition of the most tragic episodes of our most recent history. Education and Culture, as the pillars on which memory rests, are decisive elements in the promotion of open, inclusive and plural forms of citizenship with full awareness of their own history, capable of detecting and deactivating the totalitarian or anti-democratic drifts that are growing within it.
